Once students have learned the song, ask them to sing every "snowflakes, snowflakes," while you sing the other parts. Switch jobs.

Give four students a snowflake or white scarf. Let those students, one at a time, stand and sing the sol-mi pattern while everyone else sings the rest of the song.

Those four students then improvise snowflake movement while you improvise at the guitar. (You could use any instrument for this: recorder, piano, glockenspiel, etc.)

Students pass snowflake (or white scarf) to another child.

Continue until everyone has had a turn.

* For a variation, students could play the sol-mi pattern at barred instruments, and pass their mallets to the next child.
